The Program is currently funding nearly \$5,000,000 for more than 200 projects throughout the state. His responsibilities include accepting applications and making recommendations for award based on the projects meeting Program Requirements, developing an MOU between the sponsor and SHA for each project., tracking the progress of each project, offering assistance to each project sponsor to assure the project is developed within the Program Guidelines, and determining the status of the financial awards and reimbursements. He was also responsible for developing the Sponsor Guidelines Manual to guide sponsor through the program requirements. Additionally, he develops a quarterly report to show the current action on each project.</li> <li>• <b>Project Manager-Scenic Byways Program:</b> Mr. Califano currently assists MD SHA in the management of the Scenic Byways Program. The Program is currently funding more than \$3,000,000 for more the 30 projects throughout the state. His responsibilities include soliciting for new projects on an annual basis and assisting committee members in reviewing the applications and selecting projects for award. He also works with each project sponsor in completing the project within the Program requirements including, developing an MOU between the sponsor and SHA, selecting consultant services, design, advertising, bidding, award and reimbursement.</li> <li>• <b>Project Manager-Transportation Enhancement Program:</b> Mr. Califano was responsible for establishing and implementing the construction management procedures for the Transportation Enhancement Program within the State of Maryland under the first authorization period starting in 1991. For the initial four years of the Program, he managed the development of the projects in accordance with the Program requirements. His responsibilities included project design review, preparation of bid book and project oversight during the advertisement, bidding and award of the project.
